Small Business and the current economic climate

As professors Nots O. Smart and M.A. Kaloss (Well-known advisors to the government and in particular the Dept of Industry) write: "In these tough times for small businesses there is an alternative to long hours of work, endless government red tape, chasing poor payers, staff issues, rising costs, bad depts, lower margins and customers: BANKRUPTCY."

They will take you step by step into a stress free world. This week the subject of pricing is examined.

One of the secrets to an easy decline into bankruptcy is to be the cheapest in town and that can be achieved with a little effort:

- 1. Cut your day to day prices by 30%
- 2. When the wholesalers reduce their prices, don't pocket the extra margin but pass on the price cuts in full to your customers.
- 3. When quoting structural go in at cost less 15%. Make the national conglomerates wonder how you buy so well. Think of that wonderful feeling when you win a tender against the odds.
- 4. If you run a busy counter forget those big margins (and the time it takes to fill a \$5.00 order). Go in at cost plus 10%. You will have people driving from the surrounding suburbs, past your competitors, just to pick up their 5 metal threads,nuts and washers.
- 5. Have your rep find out what the opposition is charging at potential customers and beat it by 25% instead of shaving the price to retain some margin.

If you put into action these ideas you will be well on the way to bankruptcy but there is still more to do.In the next issue staff training will be examined.
